



Sci-Tech Camper Code of Conduct

All campers signed a Code of Conduct with their families before coming to camp.

Taking Care of Myself and Others:

- I will not harm myself or others.
- I will communicate my needs and feelings to the best of my ability using respectful and kind words.
- I will take care of myself by eating, staying hydrated, and practicing good hygiene while at camp.
- I will respect the physical space of others and will not rough house or touch others in ways they don't like or ways that could intentionally or unintentionally hurt them.
- I will not wear clothing or bring games/objects that promote alcohol or drugs, contain foul language or jokes, or that are inappropriate for an inclusive camp environment.

On the Halls:

- I will be sharing my living space with other campers and will be respectful (show *kavod*) of their feelings, right to express themselves, and their property.
- I will respect others' property by not touching or playing with things in ways the owner doesn't like.
- I will not enter any bedroom that is not my own.
- I will not enter a dorm building or hall that is not my own, unless I have staff permission.
- I will always wear camp-appropriate clothing that covers my body, even while on the hall.

Interacting with Staff:

- I will follow the directions of the adults, staff, and CITs (Machon) at camp.
- I will respect staff and CITs (Machon) when they tell me that we are moving on to the next activity.
- I will let another staff member know if an adult or CIT (Machon) asks me to keep a secret for them, as camp is an open and safe space.

Around Camp:

- I will participate in camp programs and activities to the best of my ability.
- I will treat camp property with respect. I understand that graffiti is not allowed, and that intentional destruction of camp property will not be tolerated. My family will have to pay for any damages.
- When I have access to the internet, I promise only to access websites relevant to camp projects.
- I will not leave camp property. I will not wander away from or leave groups or activities.
- I understand that non-approved electronics, food, alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products, vaping devices, matches, fireworks, weapons (including pocketknives), or other dangerous items have no place at camp and that possession of any of these items is forbidden.

To help make Sci-Tech a kind and inclusive *Kehillah Kedosha* (holy community), I pledge to...

- Include those who are left out (*dibbuk chaverim*).
- Not participate in gossip (*lashon hara*).
- Never bully or tease others (*derech erez*).
- Never watch, laugh, or join in when someone is being bullied (*lo ta-amod al dam rayecha*).
- Tell a staff member or adult when I suspect or witness bullying (*ometz lev*).
- Have the courage to be an ally by helping those who are being bullied (*rachmanut*).
